- The Bluetooth Range can vary depending on the ambient environment. The range is s tested in an outdoor environment with no physical obstacle.
- Playtime duration can vary depending on actual usage and the volume of the device. Playtime duration is tested at 33% volume of the Bluetooth Audio device.
- 3. The IP rating determines how resistant something is to environmental elements. Most IP numbers read IPXX each "X" being a placeholder for a number. The first number represents the level of resistance to dust/particles and the second representing its ability to withstand liquid.
- 4. Driver size denotes the diameter of the diaphragm.

 5. Signal to Noise Ratio is defined as the ratio of signal power to the noise power, it is represented in decibels.
- Simpedance refers to the load a speaker places on an amplifier. Technically, impedance is the "resistance" a speaker offers to the current supplied by an amplifier because the output current of an amplifier is AC (not DC, like from a battery), this resistance is called impedance.

How to Operate

Before Powering ON for the first time, please charge fully for good battery life.

Charging

- 1. Plug the small end of the USB cable into the micro-USB connector port on the headphone
- Plug the other end into a USB wall charger/computer/power bank that is powered on.

Powering On

Long press (/O button for more than 3 seconds to power on.

Pairing Via Bluetooth

Connecting any Bluetooth device

- 1. On powering on, the headphone is in Bluetooth pairing mode automatically.
- Open the Bluetooth settings on any Bluetooth device and search for device with name "Sunno P20" and connect.

Note:

- "Suono P20 Bluetooth Headphones" will automatically re-pair with the last paired device whenever it is within range.
- 2. Devices with older Bluetooth versions may prompt you to input a passcode key. Please enter "0000" on your device and press OK to successfully connect with "Suono P20 Bluetooth Headphones"

This product is compatible with Siri/Google Assistant.

MicroSD Card Operation

When a microSD card is inserted, the audio/music stored in the microSD card will automatically start playing.

Note:

- 1. Supports MP3 and WAV audio formats only.
- The speaker also has a memory function that will recall and continue from the last-played track whenever a microSD card is reinserted into the speaker.

3.5mm Aux Cable Operation

Insert the 3.5mm AUX cable into the AUX input. "Suono P20 Bluetooth Headphones" is ready to play audio/music through AUX mode.

- Do NOT use while driving for phone calls or any other purpose.

Troubleshooting					
Problem	Solution				
No Power	Charge the battery. Connect to the power source.				
Unsuccessful Bluetooth pairing	Restart the product and try pairing again. Disable Bluetooth mode in your device and then re-enable it.				
Poor audio quality	Make sure the product is in the Bluetooth range.				
Low or no volume	Increase the volume on "Suono P20 Bluetooth Headphones" and/or connected device.				
Undiscoverable in Bluetooth pairing	The product may be paired to a different device, disconnect from the paired device. Suono P20 Bluetooth Headphones is not in Bluetooth mode, change to Bluetooth mode.
